1. *Constitutive* genes are those which are expressed in all cells of the body at all times. These genes code for proteins which are required for the basic cellular functions such as protein synthesis, DNA replication, etc.

2. *Regulatory genes* are those which control the expression of other genes. They regulate the rate of transcription or translation of the structural genes.

3. *Structural genes* are those which code for specific proteins. These genes are usually located in the nucleoplasm.

4. *Accessory genes* are those which are located outside the nucleus and code for proteins which are involved in the transport of materials across the nuclear membrane.

5. *Genes for ribosomes* are those which code for the proteins of the ribosomes. These genes are located in the nucleoplasm.

6. *Genes for enzymes* are those which code for the enzymes. These genes are located in the nucleoplasm.

7. *Genes for structural proteins* are those which code for the structural proteins. These genes are located in the nucleoplasm.

8. *Genes for regulatory proteins* are those which code for the regulatory proteins. These genes are located in the nucleoplasm.

9. *Genes for transport proteins* are those which code for the transport proteins. These genes are located in the nucleoplasm.

10. *Genes for structural proteins* are those which code for the structural proteins. These genes are located in the nucleoplasm.
